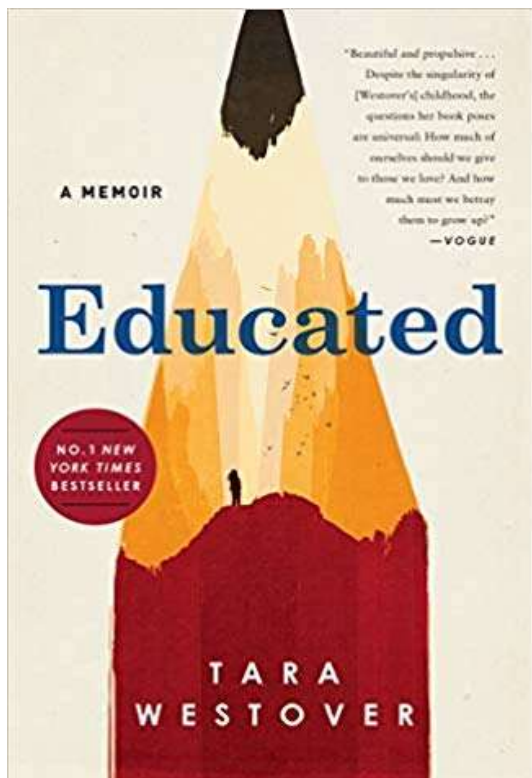


## CASA Book Club Fall Selection – Educated
