





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**Typical Developmental Milestones** 3-6 Month Old Babies Follow moving toys or face Startled by loud or new sounds Wiggle and kick legs and arms Lift their head and shoulders Smile back at family and caregivers Make gurgling, cooing, or sucking sounds 6-9 Month Old Babies Explore toys with hands and mouth Roll over Squeal and babble different sounds Sit up leaning on hands Respond to their name Enjoy games like 'peek-a-boo'

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
Typical Developmental **Milestones** -18 Month Old Babies Look at pictures in a book Use at least three words Hold a crayon in their fist Hand toys to you when asked Point to objects you name Walk without help **Month Old Toddlers** Use pointing and words together Feed themselves with their fingers Can point to one body part when asked Use at least ten words Pull off shoes and socks

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


**Developmental** Red Flags: Any Age Fusses or cries a lot, even when not tired or hungry Has trouble falling asleep or staying asleep Does not notice people Unhappy most of the time Loss of speech, babbling, or social skills



Service Delivery via Telehealth 26 TAC §350.103(41) Telehealth must be delivered using a platform that supports both audio and video communication

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


Requirements of Telehealth A family must consent in writing. Consent must indicate they can withdraw it at any time. If a family declines telehealth, services must be provided in person. Telehealth services must comply with the Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPPA) and the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). All services must comply with Medicaid, the delivery provider's practice act, and ECI rules regarding service delivery and documentation.

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
