All services are available both in-person & virtually, in English & Spanish, secular or faith-based formats on request & definition of our clients. Play Therapy is available for children as young as 4. Free Service eligibility to anyone in the surrounding areas &/or relatives impacted by the mass violence of May 18, 2018, including Santa Fe ISD Staff - Students - Parents - City Employees - First Responders - Residents on a Victim of Crime Act grant from the Governor's Office. If not eligible for grant programs, IA has sliding-scale & takes most insurance for other issues unrelated to the mass violence, but sometimes clients do not realize the connection between their symptoms &/or current family conflict to trauma. An assessment can help you know.
